#### EXPLORE WITH YOUR FAMILY:

Write the words of 1 Thessalonians 2:12 on separate index cards or pieces of paper. Mix them up and place the words along a path (to the mailbox, a tree, the car, etc.) so your child can find them. Once all the words have been found, place them in the order they were collected, and say the verse together. Relate the activity to when we don't live as God wants us to, it's like reading the words in the wrong order; it doesn't work. But when we live as God Word says, it not only makes sense, but it also pleases God.
